## **HERTFORDSHIRE ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE**

### **Followed by Lime Walk Primary School**

Hertfordshire County Council now administers all in-year admissions to Primary schools and parents must use this process to secure a place for their child.

If you are considering applying for a place at the school and would like to visit you would be very welcome. Please telephone for an appointment.

The school admits up to thirty children into each year group.

The criteria for admissions are as follows in priority order:

1. Children in public care.
2. Children for whom it can be demonstrated that they have a particular medical or social need to go to the school.
3. Children who have a sibling on the roll of the school or linked school at the time of the application for admission, unless the sibling is in the final year of the school or linked school whichever provides for the older children.
4. Children for whom the school is their nearest community of voluntary-controlled school.
5. Children who live nearest the school.
6. In Foundation Stage (Nursery and Reception classes) we operate a one intake per year system.
